Even the Parnell family was able to travel to Juneau (Track was out of state at that time the entire Parnell family was allowed a state trip to the Governor's House) Would you pls run this by Linda Perez and Mike Nizich again, as I'll continue to walk on eggshells with travel issues, not knowing why the state does what it does in terms of travel.

I dont want to sound petty about this - but until there is a sensible policy I will keep asking travel questions, even though it sure takes up a lot of valuable time.
